Tucson History & Libation **Walking Tour**

This tour is guided by Mr. Jim Gressinger, travel writer, photographer, and publisher of [Southern Arizona Guide](http://southernarizonaguide.com).

The tour takes us on a walkabout through the Tucson of the 1870's & 80's as seen through the eyes of saloonkeeper, George Hand.

Old photographs, sketches, and maps are used to locate important historical sites, along with excerpts from Mr. Hand's diary to learn about the fascinating people and events associated with these places some 140 years ago.

There will be lunch at an historic site, such as Maynards Market & Kitchen in the historic train depot. Also included are streetcar day tickets and admission to 2 small, but very interesting museums. The tour is about 3.5 hours plus lunch and walking about 2.5 miles, occasionally hopping on and off the Modern Streetcar.
